In a nurturing, camp-like environment, children engage in a variety of traditional summer camp activities combined with strong support for academic, therapeutic and social goals described in their Individual Education Plans.

Programs are available for ages 3-15 and 16-18...

- Children are divided into small, compatible groups within the following divisions
 - Bright Beginnings (ages 3-5)
 - Lower Camp
 - Middle Camp
 - Upper Camp
 - LIFE & TravelQuest Programs (ages 16-18)

...and will fit your summer schedule.

- Sessions are available for 2 to 7 weeks
- Program hours are 9:00 AM to 3:30 PM
- 3 through 5 year olds may attend full day (9-3:30) or mini day (9-12)
 - Harbor Watch Program offers optional extended hours (until 3:30) for mini day children on certain days
- Central Pick-up/Drop-off Transportation can be provided, in most cases, for regular program hours
 - NJ licensed school bus drivers
 - NJDOT approved school vehicles
 - Harbor Haven bus counselor on board at all times
 - No transportation is available for extended program hours



Language Development

 Communication skills are maintained and expanded through coaching and practice. Receptive, expressive and pragmatic communication skills are reinforced throughout

• Speech therapy groups are included for Bright Beginnings

• Individual speech therapy is available at an additional cost



Sensory Motor Enrichment

- Opportunities to develop fine and gross motor skills and practice sensory motor integration skills are embedded in daily activities
- Occupational therapy groups are included for Bright Beginnings and Lower Campers
- Individual OT is available for an additional cost
- Physical education sessions are provided multiple times each week
- Physical therapy can be arranged upon request at an additional cost

Social Skills Training

- Psychologists or social workers lead weekly social skills training groups
- Children are involved in facilitated social situations and engage in cooperative play
- Skills are reinforced throughout the day during activities through counselor facilitiation and feedback



Behavior and Attention

 Through a variety of strategies, children are encouraged to improve focus, attention and time on task.

Programs for 16-18 year old teens with mild special needs



- Unique 5-week, full day program, created by Harbor Haven's team of professionals, for 16-18 year old teens with mild special needs that provides support for meeting transition goals
- Balanced combination of structured learning experiences that promote growth in: • Daily/independent living skills; personal care, house keeping, health and
 - safety
 - Employment readiness skills
 - Financial literacy
 - Real world reading and writing • Computer and executive functioning skills • On-site jobs with coaching • Hobbies and socialization • Exposure and access to community resources • Exploring post-secondary options • Meal planning/preparation, nutrition • Travel training through out-of-camp trips (all trip/lunch locations are thoroughly vetted by Harbor Haven for health and safety protocols) • Yoga, swim, athletics, creative arts, music and more!
- Individual speech and occupational therapy available at an additional cost • The differentiation of curriculum and appropriate groupings allow for teens of varying abilities to participate

TravelQuest Program

TravelQuest is a two week day travel program for 16-18 year olds with mild special needs, created and operated by Harbor Haven. Teens can participate as a natural extension of the 5-week LIFE Program or as a stand-alone one or two week summer experience.

TravelQuest is a fun, social way for your teen to interact and experience new adventures with compatible young adults. In the TravelQuest Program, your teen is supported and supervised by professionals in education and related fields.

- Each day includes a fun trip, snacks, beverages and lunch
- All trip/lunch locations are thoroughly vetted by Harbor Haven for health and safety protocols
- Trips/lunch out are planned at predominantly outdoor locations. When an indoor activity is planned, it will take place at a venue with only Harbor Haven campers and staff members present.
- All trips leave from and return to Harbor Haven
- Participants choose one or two weeks

*All trips and entertainment are subject to cancellation based on CDC and/or NJ Health Department guidelines, community health data and other health and safety factors. In the event that trips are canceled, an alternative TeenQuest program will be offered at camp.
