Several Sources is a faith-based, 501(c)3, non-profit organization celebrating over 40 years of life-saving work. Through our three ministries, we provide cost-free services and support to pregnant women who choose life for their unborn babies.

Our Ministries in Action



Office of Maternal Child Care

The Office of Maternal Child Care (OMCC) provides safe, residential housing for pregnant women and their babies. Offered at no cost, the home-like settings are fully staffed by experienced and caring personnel who help with day-to-day needs and challenges of the residents.

Services include, but are not limited to, transport to doctors' appointments, coordinating training and education classes, assisting with application for social services, job hunting, personal development, community service participation and attending social events.



Gift of Hope

The Gift of Hope helps provide women facing unplanned pregnancy with an array of healthy choices for themselves and their pre-born baby. Our compassionate staff, led by a licensed medical director, guides each woman on parenting and life skills in a safe, non-judgmental space. In addition to modern and clean office space, the Gift of Hope has two fully equipped mobile sprinters that go out into the community to meet women where they are. Our services include OB ultrasound, lab certified pregnancy tests, referrals for OB care / Physicians, in kind donations and case management, which are free of charge to the community.



Special Families Program

The Special Families Program was designed to provide continual care after our moms and their babies leave our shelter. It is a lifeline for many of these moms who are coping with the transition to independent living. Each family receives four packages per year, which include Easter, summer backpack with school supplies, Thanksgiving and Christmas. All packages include essential food cards. In addition, special requests for assistance are handled on a case-by-case basis, which could include rental and utility assistance.

Great news! The work we do together saving babies and changing lives is expanding. We have added one more mobile unit to Our Gift of Hope Program. This vehicle was purchased in 2020 thanks, in part, to a grant from Save the Storks and a donation from a passionate benefactor. It was on delay for quite a while due to the pandemic and the economic impact on supply chains. We were excited to learn that the mobile unit would be ready for client inspection and training the week of September 12 and arriving at Several Sources on September 19.



This second mobile unit will need two staff members and security to function at high capacity. Our gas expenses will be higher than expected given the increased prices today. Additionally, we need some supplies to properly serve the women who come to us for love, care, and medical attention.



We must have our two mobile units out on the streets as much as possible and operating at the highest level of excellence. Our pro-abortion brothers and sisters who do not yet know Christ are hard at work pushing abortion everywhere you turn and they are aggressively seeking flaws in pro-life organizations in an attempt to shut them down. To save more babies, we must meet women faced with unexpected pregnancies as early as possible, and we must do so with high standards of care. Our challenge may be Goliath, but like David, we can prevail.


